Dear Parents,

The mission of the Enrichment Program is designed to chart a course of excellence in academics for junior/senior high-school aged students of home study programs in Thomasville and surrounding areas. Having successfully completed this mission for the past two years, we are very excited moving into our third school year of the program. Based on our experience in the program and your interest revealed in the surveys, we have formulated the attached 2009-2010 schedule.

We anticipate some will have tough choices between different classes offered to highschoolers. Please keep in mind that classes repeat every year or every other year, so there will be a future opportunity if you are unable to take a class next year. The class minimums determine the tuition amounts for the program. If the class minimums are not met, these classes may have to be cancelled or tuition raised for those specific classes.

Please note, we are renaming a couple of courses to better relay the information taught in those classes. What was formally known as Grammar and Comp 1 is now called Writing 1, and Grammar and Comp 2 is now called Writing 2 (because the Writeshop curriculum focuses on writing). Each class will still be accepted as full year of Language Arts for high school students. For junior high students, Grammar and Comp 1 and 2 primarily focuses on traditional grammar, diagramming, research skills, in depth study of eight parts of speech, and spelling and vocabulary words. While this class is designed for 7th and 8th graders to shore up on those areas before entering the writing classes, older students that need a “refresher” course in grammar are also welcome.

We have created a separate schedule for 7th and 8th graders. The classes designated for high school students will be taught at a level for which, in our experience, 7th and 8th graders are not prepared. We will not allow 7th and 8th graders to sign up for high school level classes with the exception of an 8th grader that is ready to take Algebra 1 because they have completed the Pre-Algebra course.

The following are deadlines and requirements we have set for registering for next year: By June 1, 2009, your family must be a member of CHART for the 2009-2010 school year, and each child's EP application, each child's EP registration fee, Volunteer Sign-Up form and the signed EP Financial Agreement must be turned in to Deeann Johnson or mailed to P.O. Box 7055, Thomasville, GA 31758. This packet will be available on the forums and the CHART website by April 1.
